

Loose Powder Mineral Eye Shadows

simple mineral-based cosmetics for eyes

Ingredients

- 1/8 teaspoon Magnesium Stearate NF
- 1/4 teaspoon Arrowroot Powder
- 1/4 teaspoon eye-safe Mica
- 4 drops Clear Jojoba

Makes about 5/8 teaspoon eye shadow - enough to fill 1 4ml Crystal Jar

Directions:

- 1. In a tiny mixing vessel, combine magnesium stearate and arrowroot powder with mica. You may use one type of mica, or a blend of several colors for each batch.
- 2. Add up to 4 drops of jojoba, then mix well to thoroughly blend ingredients. Be sure to break up any clumps that form.
- 3. Carefully transfer mixture to clean jars.

Usage & Packaging:

- We used our Crystal Jars to package our eye shadows. These jars hold about 4 ml and are the perfect size for this recipe. For larger batches, check out our 15 ml jar and sifters.
- To use, simply brush color onto lids with cosmetic brush.

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
