



Lavender Mint Lip Balm

a simple lip balm with fragrant lavender

Ingredients

- 60 grams White Beeswax Pellets
- 60 grams Deodorized Cocoa Butter
- 30 grams Organic Babassu Oil
- 30 grams Brazil Nut Oil
- 5 grams Organic Castor Oil
- 5 grams Organic Sunflower Lecithin Liquid
- 1.25 ml Organic Peppermint Essential Oil
- 1.25 ml Organic Lavender Bud Select CO2 Extract

Makes about 190 grams, enough to make about thirty six 0.15 oz. tubes

Directions:

1. Heat beeswax, cocoa butter, and babassu oil in double boiler until fully melted.
2. Remove melted ingredients from heat and add brazil nut oil, sunflower lecithin, and castor oil. Mix well until solids dissolve completely. Let stand 3-5 minutes to reduce excess heat.
3. Add peppermint essential oil and lavender CO2 extract. Stir well, then pour into lip balm tubes, tins, or jars.

Usage & Packaging:
